












OUR MISSION



Throughout his tenure, Coach Doyle has been recognized as the 2009 Metro Coach of the Year and Associated Press 3A State Coach of the Year, 2010 Washington State Baseball Coaches Association All State Coach, 2014 Seattle Times- Star Times Coach of the Year, and the 2015 Northwest Baseball Umpires Association Coach of the Year.

After completing his Bachelor's Degree in History at Gonzaga University, Coach Doyle completed his student teaching at O'Dea, and has been a full-time faculty member since 2007. He teaches 11th grade United States History, as well as Elective Courses Modern American History, Conflict in the 20th Century, and Political Science. Coach Doyle shares in his baseball passion with his wife Brittany and children Barrett and Caprice.





Drew Snider // VARSITY HEAD COACH

Head Coach Drew Snider started the O'Dea High School Lacrosse Program in 2014. During the inaugural season Coach Snider lead the Irish to a 5-9 record in Div. II with zero seniors and only five juniors. In 2015 Coach Snider and the Irish moved up to Div. I and finished with a winning record of 8-6 just missing the playoffs. In 2016, Snider led the Irish to their first D1 playoff and ultimately losing in the Elite-8. Drew graduated from O'Dea in 2006 as a two-time All-American and went on to play at the University of Maryland. At Maryland Snider lead his team to two NCAA Div. I National Championship appearances being crowned captain his senior season. After Maryland, Snider was drafted by Major League Lacrosse's Denver Outlaws and won a world championship in 2014. Snider was named captain of the team in 2016, and he led them

to their second MLL Championship that same year. Drew also practiced with the Washington Stealth in the National Lacrosse League in 2013. On an international level Snider was selected to team USA's 30-man roster for the 2014 world games (every 4 years) just missing the 23-man roster. In 2015 Snider was selected to team USA in the World Indoor Lacrosse Championships (every 4 years) winning the bronze medal. Drew is also an assistant coach at University of Washington and has recently founded a youth lacrosse organization called CitySideLax. Drew grew up in Queen Anne and currently lives in Capitol Hill. He spends his free time with his parents Jacqueline and Kris Snider, his sister Catherine, and brother Will.




