## Message from the Principal Surface Tablet Program

In anticipation of our transition to the Surface Tablet program, I am excited to inform you that "e-resources" (textbooks and other classroom tools) will be integrated into virtually every O'Dea class for the 2017-2018 school year. These resources will provide our students and faculty excellent classroom tools, encourage the use of the Surface, eliminate heavy books, and are cost effective for our families.

O'Dea will purchase all necessary e-resources and deliver them electronically to your student before the start of the school year. We are aware of the high cost of textbooks in the past and therefore are pleased to share that the cost of these e-resources to our families for the 2017-2018 school year will be \$200 per student. Families may be required to purchase a few additional low-cost resources, such as workbooks for world language and paperback novels for literature, but the structure of this program allows us to pass significant savings on to you. In future years, we will incorporate this resource fee into our tuition contract, but this year we will ask families to pay the \$200 fee by November 1st.

On Tuesday, May 23rd at either 1:00 p.m. or 6:00 p.m. we invite you to join us in the O'Dea library to learn more about our Surface Tablet program. David Olinger, Director of Educational Technology, will provide information and answer your questions to help ensure a successful transition for your family.
