Academics & Counseling Important Information on Surface Tablet Purchases

We hope you will soon have purchased your son's Surface device to allow for delivery in time for the coming school year. As you know, SHI has been a preferred vendor for us due to the excellent warranty they offer. Unfortunately, families who have purchased from SHI have not received the quality service we anticipated. We have been working diligently with them to solve the service problems, and while they have improved in many areas, families are still encountering issues. We want to remind you that unless you are receiving financial aid to help purchase your Surface device, you are under no obligation to buy it through SHI. It is unlikely you will find the same warranty elsewhere, but you will likely receive more efficient service.

As an alternative you may want to purchase from the Microsoft store, with many locations in the greater Seattle area. Be sure to ask for an education bundle and have a Student ID Card with you in case they require it. If you are planning to purchase your device through SHI, **please do so no later than July 31st to ensure delivery in time for the school year**.
