



Current parents, past parents, and alumni responded with enthusiasm ensuring we could create the best learning environment possible for our students.

As a past parent of two O'Dea graduates, Kristian '01 and Kristopher '05, Mike understands firsthand the impact that O'Dea High School has had on developing the character, strength, and resolve of his boys. Kristian and Kristopher attended O'Dea because Mike wanted them to be academically and ethically challenged. Along the way they learned from the loyalty and sincerity of the faculty and staff, developed from boys to gentlemen, and



experienced the longstanding traditions of O'Dea that will never be forgotten.

MASS FOR DECEASED HOMELESS

Members of the O'Dea community joined other Catholic schools, and people from the Seattle area, to celebrate mass at St. James Cathedral honoring homeless men and women that have passed away in Seattle over the last year. This year, there were over 50 O'Dea students in attendance. During the mass, 92 bells were rung, one for each person who died. Also present at the event were Archbishop Sartain and Mayor Ed Murray. This was a really great opportunity for O'Dea students to show their commitment to service and to show that they care about the issues that are prevalent in the community.

THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

For the second year in a row, students who would like to become Catholic had the opportunity to participate in the RCIA program through St. James Cathedral. Initiates took classes and were then welcomed into the Church. This year, the O'Dea Community was pleased to welcome three new members to the Catholic Church: Dakota Cruz '17, Brandon Duffy '18, and Jack Markowitz '18. These young men spent nearly two years in preparing themselves both in knowledge and in the Spirit to reach this moment. What a great witness they have been to the O'Dea Community and the Church.

ENCOUNTER RETREATS

The Encounter Retreats were a huge success with some phenomenal senior leaders who set the tone for the

retreat with their engaging talks and willingness to share. Through group talks, game time, good food, and multiple opportunities to partake in the sacraments, the feeling of brotherhood grew and students and adults alike bonded in friendship. Encounter is truly the spirit of the O'Dea Brotherhood.

BEARDS FOR BROS-"FIGHTING IRISH, FIGHTING CANCER"

For the second year in a row, the young men at O'Dea put on the Beards for Bros Fundraiser. The purpose of Beards for Bros is to raise awareness about cancer in the school community. The main way for students to participate was to become an official "beard grower". This year, the goal of \$10,000 was surpassed and all of the money raised went to support the Seattle Children's Adolescent and Young Adult Cancer Program.

CHRISTMAS FAMILY PROJECT

Each year O'Dea participates in Providence Regina House's Adopt-a-Family program. This year was no different as our community came together to wrap and deliver Christmas cheer to 12 families in need. The energy in the school was humbling, warm and authentic! One student reflected: "When we arrived into the old apartment building an adorable 4 year old girl let us into their very sparse apartment with a small table top tree and a manger scene. We started piling all the gifts around the tree while the family sat on the couch and beamed. The Mom was so overjoyed, she got very teary-eyed and

hugged us multiple times. As we left she said, "Navidad es salud, trabajo, viento todos de la familia". We later learned that meant, "Christmas is about health, work and bringing together the whole family."

DINNER WITH THE HOMELESS

Each year St. Anne's Parish and School host the annual Dinner with the Homeless. Although the event is hosted by St. Anne's, O'Dea has had an integral and unique opportunity to participate since the dinner moved from the homeless shelters in the late 1980s. Through the leadership of legendary O'Dea Soccer Coach and St. Anne's parishioner, Pat Raney, O'Dea began providing the homeless with transportation from various shelters up to St. Anne's for dinner, music and gifts. Using the recognizable maroon and gold buses, O'Dea has been able to help serve a population that needs to be shown compassion. It's a service we are grateful to provide and hope to continue for years to come.

TOILET PAPER DRIVE

This February, O'Dea and Holy Names joined forces and collected over 2,500 rolls of toilet paper to benefit Jubilee Women's Center (JWC). Jubilee Women's Center is an organization that promotes the infinite worth and dignity of women who have been victims of domestic violence, homelessness, and poverty. The representatives at JWC were so grateful for the donation and impressed by the collaborative efforts. Not only did the Toilet Paper Drive broaden our community relations, it strengthened our

relationship with Holy Names and benefited marginalized women in our community.

O'DEA & HOLY NAMES HELP EARTHCORPS

O'Dea and HNA partnered with EarthCorps to improve the Woodland Park forest. Student volunteers planted native species and spread mulch to prevent weed growth. In reflecting on their hard work, students expressed the joy they felt from cleaning up the environment, making it better for the future, and seeing their work pay off immediately.

RELAX FOR A CAUSE

On the first Friday of each month, O'Dea permits students to "Relax for a Cause". Student leaders identify important issues and execute an all-school outreach for that cause. Students who participate in the outreach are permitted to break school dress code for that day. In the 2015–16 school year O'Dea students delivered collected goods and cash donations to Northwest Harvest, Jubilee Women's Shelter, The Red Cross, St. James' Youth Migrant Project, Mana Books, Orion Center Youth Care, and Providence Regina House.

FOOTBALL

Congrats to head coach Monte Kohler and the Fighting Irish football team on a hard fought season. Their 2015 campaign ended with a 7–3 record following a season ending loss to a competitive Lakes High School. We commend our student-athletes for their efforts; the fine young men that made up the 2015 Fighting Irish team are special people with great character. One of the challenges faced by the 2015 team was its youth. We feel very confident that the growth pains will lead to dominant success in the years to come.

CROSS COUNTRY

The 2015 Fighting Irish Cross Country team had an impressive championship season led by head coach David Bazzi '96. Sophomore Isaac Mohn led the Irish with his 8th

place finish at Metros, followed by senior captain Henry Newstrom's 13th place finish. O'Dea placed 9th overall in the District Championships, and both Isaac Mohn and Henry Newstrom individually qualified for the State Championships.

GOLF

The Irish Golf team had a very successful season under head coach Brian Vaughan. Representing O'Dea at the Metro tournament were three seniors, Jack Fox, Sam Edmonds and Noah Ewert, junior Isaiah Khan, sophomore Garrett Spragins, and freshman Jack Summers. Jack and Sam made it to Districts, with Sam advancing on to the State Championships. The team also included senior Daniel Henry, and sophomores Jake Murray and Stephen Scheer. We have a promising young squad of Irish golfers that should be strong contenders for years to come!

WINTER SPORTS

BASKETBALL

Congratulations to our Irish Hoopers for advancing to the 2016 3A Boys Championship Game and finishing the season with a 22-8 record and 2nd in State under the guidance of head coach Jason Kerr. The effort and achievements by these young men proudly represented our school and the entire O'Dea community. With many returning players with State tournament experience, the future is looking bright for our young Irish Hoopers!

WRESTLING

Congratulations to head coach Jeff Anderson and our Irish Wrestlers on an impressive season! These young men represented O'Dea High School well with 27 wrestlers competing in the Metro League Tournament, 7 of which advanced to the Metro League finals leading the Irish to a Metro League Championship. The Irish Wrestlers dominated the Region 2 Tournament scoring a phenomenal 289.5 points, 127 points in front of the

second place team. O'Dea qualified 14 wrestlers and 3 alternates for the Mat Classic State Tournament where they took on the best in the state. Sensational Senior (and first year wrestler) Julius McDade turned in a super effort and placed 6th overall!

SWIM & DIVE

Congratulations to head coach Tom Schutte and our Irish Swim & Dive Team for finishing the championship season with strong team finishes including 4th at Metro, 8th at Districts, and 9th at the 3A State meet. Senior Justin Leary-Bignayan broke the O'Dea school record in the 100 Breast with a fast 59.47 seconds placing him 7th overall. Junior Casey Benson had a strong showing in Diving winning him a 3rd place medal. Sam Regimbal, Justin, Joey Vacura, and Ollie Depina placed 8th in the Medley Relay and 6th in the 200 Free Relay. Great performances by all Fighting Irish swimmers and divers!



SPRING SPORTS

LACROSSE

The Fighting Irish Lacrosse Program completed a very successful campaign in 2016 under the guidance of head coach Drew Snider '06. In only the third year of the program, the Irish finished with an overall record of 8–6, and a Metro conference record of 7–2. The Irish earned their first post-season playoff game and prevailed victorious over #2 Sehome. This win placed the Irish in the "elite eight" of Division 1, the toughest lacrosse program in the state; no other program has achieved this in only it's third year of a program! The Irish ended their impressive season in the quarterfinals of state with a loss to #1 ranked Bellevue who went on to win another state championship.

Congratulations to Mark Hastings (defense), Cole Daninger (midfield), and Sam Dracobly (attack) on being named to First Team All Metro.

BASEBALL

The O'Dea Baseball program, led by head Coach Mike Doyle '97, finished up a successful 2016 campaign with a combined (Varsity, JV, Freshman) record of 40–17. Varsity finished with the 4th best Metro league regular season record, and JV ended the season at an impressive 19–1. The Varsity team had three members recognized by the Metro League coaches on the All League Team: Spencer McCabe '17–1st Team DH, Jacob Hirsh '16–2nd Team OF, Marques Titialii '17–2nd Team P. Festus Gilligan '16, Jack Fox '16, Nick Miller '17, Ben Patacsil '19, Gabe Orint '17, Seth Delgado '17 were all recognized as Honorable

TRACK & FIELD

The Irish Track Team, under the guidance of head coach Vince Butorac, finished their impressive season placing 8th in Statel Senior Race Porter finished 8th in the hurdles and the 4 x 100 team made up of Logan and Landon Armstrong, Ben Johnson, and Evan Mafilas placed 5th. Logan also placed 7th in the 100, and Peter Jones took 6th in the high jump. Repeating as state champion in the 400 was Evan Mafilas with a personal best time of 48.45. Evan also took second in the 200.

SOCCER

Congratulations to head coach Kevin Fieser '04 and the Irish Soccer team for finishing the season with an 11–3–2 record. The team finished 1st in the Sound Division with the best regular season record in Metro. The Irish had the stingiest defense in the league and the third most prolific offense league wide. Several players received postseason recognition with senior Sam Johnson being

selected to the Seattle Times Star Times team. Joining Sam on first team All-Sound Division were sophomores Teddy Nickerson (Goalkeeper), team MVP Derivan Dockter (defender), Banks Telkamp (forward) and junior John Swann (forward). Receiving second team recognition were seniors Brendan McGonigle (defender), Mac Earle (midfielder) and Adrian Andersen (forward). Freshman Aaron Craddock and sophomore Stephan Scheer were both selected as Honorable mention midfielders. It was a great season and the Irish will be working hard in the offseason to capture the Metro and state titles next year.
