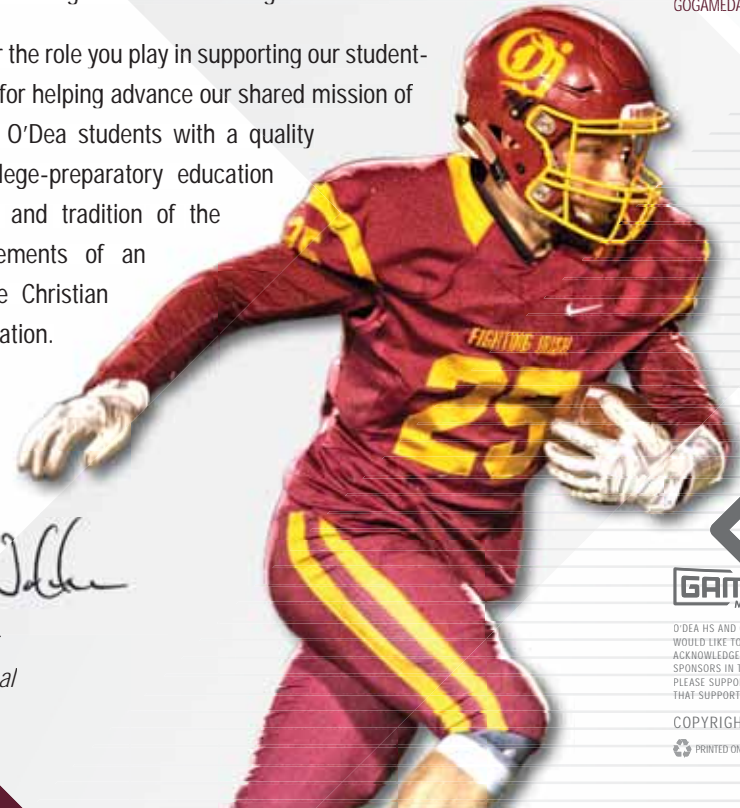

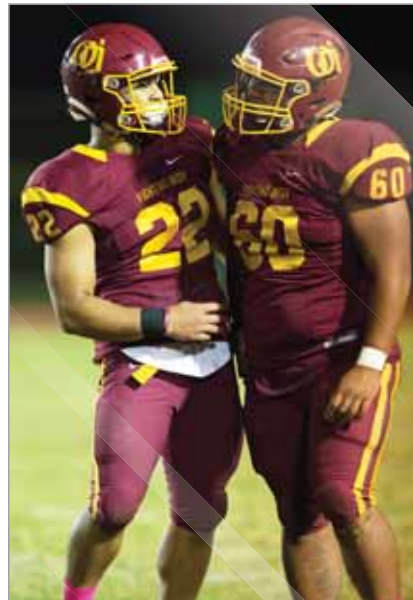

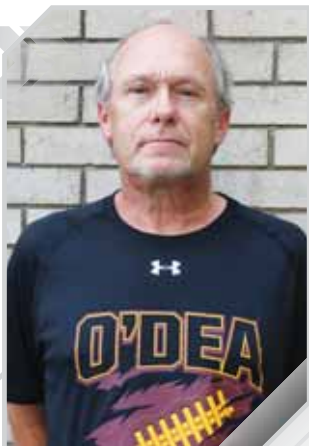

Monte Kohler >> VARSITY HEAD COACH

Coach Monte Kohler has been the Head Coach at O'Dea High School since 1985. In his 33 years coaching he has led his teams to four State Championships (1991, 1994, 1995, 2017), 25 League or Division Championships, and 25 consecutive State Tournament appearances. Kohler's teams have qualified for the WIAA State football Championships 30 times; they have been State finalists 10 times. In his coaching career he has an overall record of 324-53, which ranks Kohler 2nd for number of wins amongst all football coaches in the state of Washington. Kohler's teams have also been named Academic State Champions three times (1993, 1995, 1999). Monte was inducted into O'Dea High School's Wall of Fame in 2000, the Washington State Football Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2010, and the Pacific Northwest Hall of Fame in 2014. He has served as O'Dea's Athletic Director for 32 years and teaches A.P. History. Monte enjoys spending time with his wife, Jana, son John-Edward, daughter Cody-Marie, step-daughter Ashley, and step-son Race. They also have two grandchildren: John-Phillip and Parker-Marie.



Kevin Chandler >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Kevin Chandler '82 is a proud alum of O'Dea High School where he played QB for the Fighting Irish before playing QB for Montana State University. He has been a football coach for O'Dea High School since 1995, when the Irish won the state title. Coach Chandler is also a Math Teacher at Inglewood Middle School and in 2014 was named Outstanding Educator. He has also been nominated for the Presidential Award for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST) and was recently named a Math Fellow to serve on an advisory board for OSPI and the Lake Washington School District. He is an active member of St. Catherine of Sienna Parish in Seattle and the Knights of Columbus.



Mike Crotty >> DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Coach Mike Crotty played football at the University of Notre Dame where he was a 3 year letterman and 2 year starter as the Free Safety for Hall of Fame Head Coach, Ara Parseghian. After his senior year, Mike started in the Lion's Club American Bowl in Florida, an All-Star game for colleges across the nation. He has coached football for 27 years, 25 of which have been with O'Dea. He was the Defensive Coordinator for O'Dea's 1995 State Championship team; that season Crotty's defense had 11 shutouts in 13 games. Coach Crotty was also the Running Backs and Defensive Backs coach for the 1994 State Championship team. In 1999, 2016 and 2017 Coach Crotty was named Washington State Assistant Coach of the Year. He currently serves as O'Dea's Defensive Coordinator. Mike has three children and a grand-daughter, Mia.



Al Roberts >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Al Roberts has been coaching football for 48 years. He began his coaching career at Mercer Island High School from 1969-1972 and then became the head coach at Garfield High School from 1973-1976. From 1977-1982 Roberts was the Running Backs coach on Don James' staff at the University of Washington. He then joined the Los Angeles Express of the USFL in 1983 under Head Coach Hugh Campbell before following Campbell to the Houston Oilers in 1984. After one year stints on the college staffs at Purdue University and the University of Wyoming, Al joined Buddy Ryan with the Philadelphia Eagles in 1988. He served as the Eagles' Special Teams coach for three seasons, and held the same position with the New York Jets from 1991 to 1993, the Arizona Cardinals from 1994-1995, and the Cincinnati Bengals from 1997-2002. Coach Roberts is entering his 7th year with O'Dea High School where he works with Special Teams, Running Backs and Outside Linebackers. Roberts and his wife, Arvella, have two sons, Kali and Kyle, a daughter, Genesis, and a granddaughter, Hayvon.



Tim Greenan >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Tim Greenan is a proud O'Dea Alum (Class of 1980) and a former Irish football player. Greenan graduated from Gonzaga University and has since returned to O'Dea where he is entering his 28th season as a coach of both Offensive and Defensive Linemen. Greenan has coached numerous O'Dea Linemen that went on to play at the collegiate level, and a few that went on to the NFL. Tim teaches History at O'Dea High School. He and his wife, Heidi, have two sons, Mac and Finn.



Joe Cronin >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Joe Cronin played Center and Defensive Lineman at Everett High School and started in the East-West All-Star Game in 1999. He began the first 8 years of his coaching career at Lake Stevens High School, serving the last 5 as Defensive Coordinator. In 2012 Cronin became the Head Coach of Cascade High School where he led a previously 0-25 team to the State Playoffs in just two years. During this time Cronin was named Everett Herald Football Coach of the Year for two consecutive years and was twice named Seattle Seahawks Coach of the Week. This is Cronin's 5th year with O'Dea where he is also a Math teacher and the Dean of the Kilkenny House. He has been married to his wife, Jamie, for 5 years and together they have a 4 year old daughter, Kylie, and a 2 year old son, Brady.



Brandon Maul >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Brandon Maul played Wide Receiver and Defensive Back at Bellarmine Prep High School and started in the East-West All-Star Game in 2003. Maul went on to play Defensive Back at Santa Barbara City College and Central Washington University. He began the first 5 years of his coaching career at Bellarmine Prep and has now been with O'Dea High School for 7 years assisting with both Wide Receivers and Defensive Backs. Brandon currently serves as the P.E. teacher at O'Dea High School and is also an assistant coach for the track team. He and his wife, Chelsey, have two kids, Boede 7 and Avery 4.



James Beck >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach James Beck is a proud O'Dea Alum (Class of 2001) where he was a two-sport athlete. James played Running Back and Defensive Back for the Irish and in 2000 was named to the All-Metro League first team as a Running Back on offense and Cornerback on defense. He also ran track for O'Dea and to this day holds the school's record for the 4 x 400 relay. James went on to run track at Yale University and remains on their all-time list in the 4 X 100 relay. He also played Defensive Back at Yale University. This will be James' 5th year coaching both football and track at O'Dea High School. He is also a School Counselor.



Nick Baker >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Nick Baker played quarterback at Lake Stevens High School from 2005-2009 and from there went on to play quarterback for Montana Tech University in Butte, Montana. Coach Baker began his coaching career with the Everett Seagulls where he helped on the offensive side of the ball. He is now entering his 3rd year with O'Dea High School teaching Math and coaching quarterbacks.



Stafford Mays >> ASSISTANT COACH

Stafford played for the University of Washington football team, graduating in 1979. He played for 10 years in the NFL for the St. Louis football Cardinals and Minnesota Vikings. After his football career, Stafford worked 20+ years at Microsoft. He managed public relations and media as well as print and online initiatives for the Global Diversity and Inclusion team. He congruently established relationships with outside civil rights and human service organizations, K-12 schools, minority colleges and universities. Stafford worked to create and implement programs that give underserved communities equal access to technology. His efforts helped to provide Microsoft products and training to minority students and their teachers. Stafford has served on several Seattle-area nonprofit boards and often speaks at K-12 schools about the importance of academics and technology. His son, Taylor Mays is an O'Dea alum graduating in the Class of 2006 and his son, Parker, graduated from Seattle Prep in 2012.



Robert Espinosa >> ASSISTANT COACH

Robert Espinosa joins the Fighting Irish coaching staff with over two decades of experience as a player and a coach. He is an alum of St. Paul High School in California where he played under legendary coach Marijon Ancich. In college he was a four year running back at Azusa Pacific University, setting the record for the winningest class in school history. Espinosa was the 2002 Cougar Award recipient and a member of Azusa's 1998 National Championship Team; he graduated with a degree in Biblical Studies. Espinosa has coached football at the University of Puget Sound, Eastside Catholic and Bishop Mora Salesian High School in East Los Angeles. Coach Espinosa is entering his first year at O'Dea where he is also a Freshmen Theology Teacher. When he is not coaching or teaching, Robert likes to take his wife and kids on various outings such as fishing, swimming, or looking for Sasquatch.



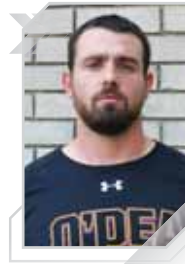
Stephan Carton >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Stephen Carton played linebacker for Trinity College in Dublin, Ireland. While earning his Bachelor and Masters in Mechanical Engineering in 2009, Stephen became a coach for Trinity College Dublin and in 2012 was named the Head Coach. In 2015 he moved to San Francisco and began coaching with the Galileo Lions where he coached wide receivers and defensive backs. In 2017, Galileo High School became the first public school in California to win a State Championship (Division 6A). This will be his first year coaching with O'Dea High School.



Morgan Davidson >> ASSISTANT COACH

Coach Morgan Davidson is a proud O'Dea Alum, graduating in the class of 2000. During his time at O'Dea, Morgan played both Offensive and Defensive Line under coaches Kohler, Greenan, Crotty, Chandler and Anderson. This will be Coach Davidson's 8th year with O'Dea. Outside of coaching Morgan enjoys spending time outdoors and the stock market.



Paxton Paynter >> HEAD STRENGTH & CONDITIONING COACH

Coach Paxton Paynter played quarterback at Lake Stevens High School and Rocky Mountain College in Billings, Montana. He then began his coaching career at Cascade High School in 2012 where he coached quarterbacks and served as the Head Strength & Conditioning Coach. In 2015 Paynter was an intern for the University of Washington football team, along with the Head Strength & Conditioning Coach at Lake Stevens High School. He is now entering his 3rd year as the full-time Strength & Conditioning Coach for O'Dea where he is responsible for training all student-athletes. Paxton recently married his beautiful wife, Michelle.



Ben Szocik >> ATHLETIC TRAINER

Athletic Trainer Ben Szocik started working at O'Dea in 2013. Ben has been a certified athletic trainer for 8 years, and holds a certified strength and conditioning coach credential through the National Strength and Conditioning Association. Besides working with high school athletic programs, Ben has covered Division I Athletics, marathons, USA Rugby matches, and numerous tournaments for a variety of sports and age groups. In addition to athletic training responsibilities, Ben teaches Introduction to Sports Medicine at O'Dea, a class that encourages O'Dea students to lend a hand along the sidelines during sporting competitions throughout the school year. In his spare time, he enjoys being outdoors, eating, reading, traveling, and spending time with friends and family.



Jim Walters >> ATHLETIC TRAINER

Coach Jim Walters graduated from Eastern Washington University where he earned a varsity letter in track and field. He was an assistant coach for O'Dea's 2003 & 2004 state championship track teams and the Head Freshmen Football Coach in 2006 & 2007. Mr. Walters has been teaching and coaching both football and track in the Seattle Archdiocese for over 35 years. During this time, he has taught Sports Medicine, Anatomy and Physiology, and has served as Dean of Students and Athletic Director. Walters currently teaches Senior English. He is a long-time member of the Washington State Coaches Association, a member of the National Athletic Training Association, a professional member of the American College of Sports Medicine, and a Nationally Certified Instructor Trainer for Medic First Aid. Jim and his wife Susan have three daughters: Kara, Jie, and Mei.

FOOTBALL POSITIONS
OFFENSE

QUARTERBACK (QB): The player who receives the ball from the center at the start of each play before either handing it to the running back, throwing it to a receiver, or running with it himself. The quarterback is usually the player in charge of running the offense on the field. He is also the guy that usually informs the offense of the play while in the huddle.

CENTER (C): The offensive lineman who hikes (or snaps) the ball to the quarterback at the start of each play. The center lines up in the middle of the offensive line, between the offensive guards.

GUARD (LG/RG): A member of the offensive line. There are two guards on every play, and they line up on either side of the offensive center.

OFFENSIVE TACKLE (LT/RT): A member of the offensive line. There are two tackles on every play, and they line up on the outside of the offensive guards.

TIGHT END (TE): An offensive player who serves as a receiver and also a blocker. The TE lines up beside the offensive tackle either to the right or to the left of the QB.

WIDE RECEIVER (WR): An offensive player who lines up on or near the line of scrimmage, but split to the outside. His primary job is to catch passes from the quarterback.

FULLBACK (FB): An offensive player who lines up in the offensive backfield and generally is responsible for run-blocking for the halfback and pass-blocking for the QB. Fullbacks are usually bigger than halfbacks, and also serve as short-yardage runners.

RUNNING BACK (RB): An offensive player who lines up in the backfield and generally is responsible for carrying the ball on run plays. A running back's primary role is to run with the football, he is also used as a receiver at times.

FOOTBALL POSITIONS
DEFENSE

CORNERBACK (CB): A defensive back who generally lines up on the outside of the formation and is usually assigned to cover a wide receiver.

SAFETY (SS/FS): A defensive back who lines up in the secondary between, but generally deeper than the cornerbacks. His primary duties include helping the cornerbacks in pass coverage. There are actually two safety positions; the free safety and strong safety.

DEFENSIVE END (DE): A defensive player who lines up at the end of the defensive line. The job of the defensive end is to contain the running back on running plays to the outside, and rush the quarterback on passing plays.

DEFENSIVE TACKLE (DT): A defensive player who lines up on the interior of the defensive line. The duties of a defensive tackle include stopping the running back on running plays, getting pressure up the middle on passing plays, and occupying blockers so the LB's can roam free.

NOSE TACKLE (NT): A defensive tackle who lines up across from the center. Also known as the nose guard, the primary responsibilities of the nose tackle are to stop the run and occupy the offensive lineman to keep them from blocking the linebackers.

LINEBACKER (LB): A defensive player who lines up behind the defensive linemen and in front of the defensive backfield. The linebackers are a team's second line of defense. Each team has two outside linebackers. In a 4-3 defense, teams have one inside linebacker, which is usually referred to as a middle linebacker. In a 3-4 defense teams have two inside linebackers.

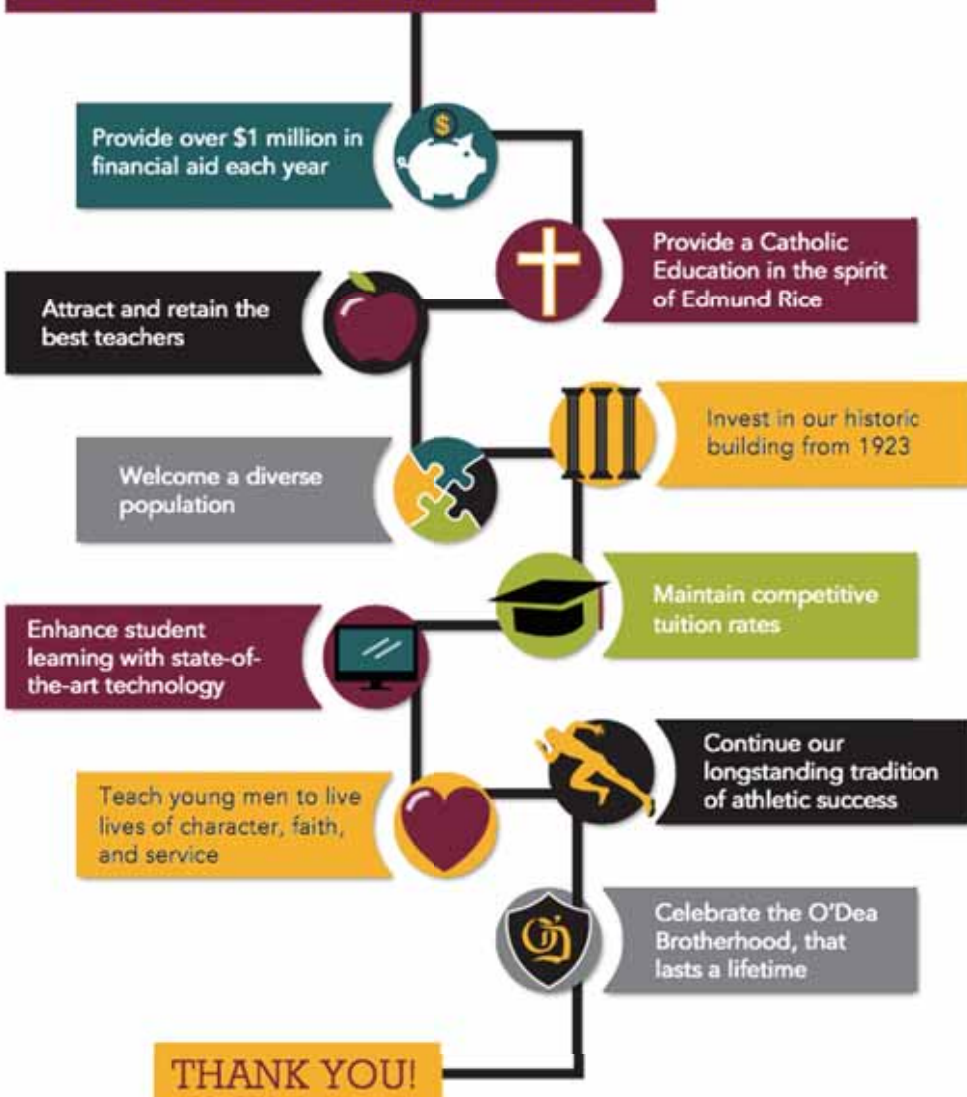
