Message from the Principal 2019-2020 Tuition

Dear O'Dea Families

As we look to the next school year, I want to make you aware of a few matters related to tuition. During a recent school board meeting, board members recommended an annual tuition rate of \$15,492, representing a 7% increase. To help accommodate the tuition increase, we will move to a twelve-month payment plan, which will decrease the amount you owe on a monthly basis.

Over the last several years we have been able to keep tuition increases to 4%. The larger increase for next year was determined necessary to help align faculty compensation with the large salary increases public school teachers received resulting from the McCleary Decision. It is essential for O'Dea to continue to retain and attract the best teachers to educate your sons, and to accomplish this we need to provide just compensation. The slightly higher tuition will make possible an increase in teacher compensation at O'Dea.

Student enrollment, course forecasting, and class registration for next year are coming soon. We will be asking you to confirm your enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year at the beginning of March. The twelve-month payment plan will have an added benefit of aligning all grade levels with a common payment schedule, making the transition from ninth to tenth grade less confusing for families. Payments will still be made through FACTS and will be paid on the first of each month from June, 2019 through May, 2020. Options to pay the entire amount in advance or semi-annually will still be available.

Thank you for your continued partnership and support of O'Dea High School and helping us advance our mission of providing a quality Catholic education to all of our students as together we strive to pursue excellence in all endeavors.
