2019-2020 Enrollment

Please remember to enroll your son by the March 15th deadline. Enrollment will now be done online! Please click [HERE](#) to complete the process and ensure your son's place at O'Dea for the next school year.

The 2019-2020 Enrollment Fee of \$500 will automatically process through your FACTS account on **March 22, 2019**, unless otherwise indicated on the online enrollment form by **March 15, 2019**, that your son is not returning to O'Dea for the 2019-2020 school year.

Your current FACTS account and payment plan will automatically roll over for 2019-2020. All tuition payments will process on the 1st of the month over 12 months, **beginning June 1, 2019** and ending May 1, 2020.
