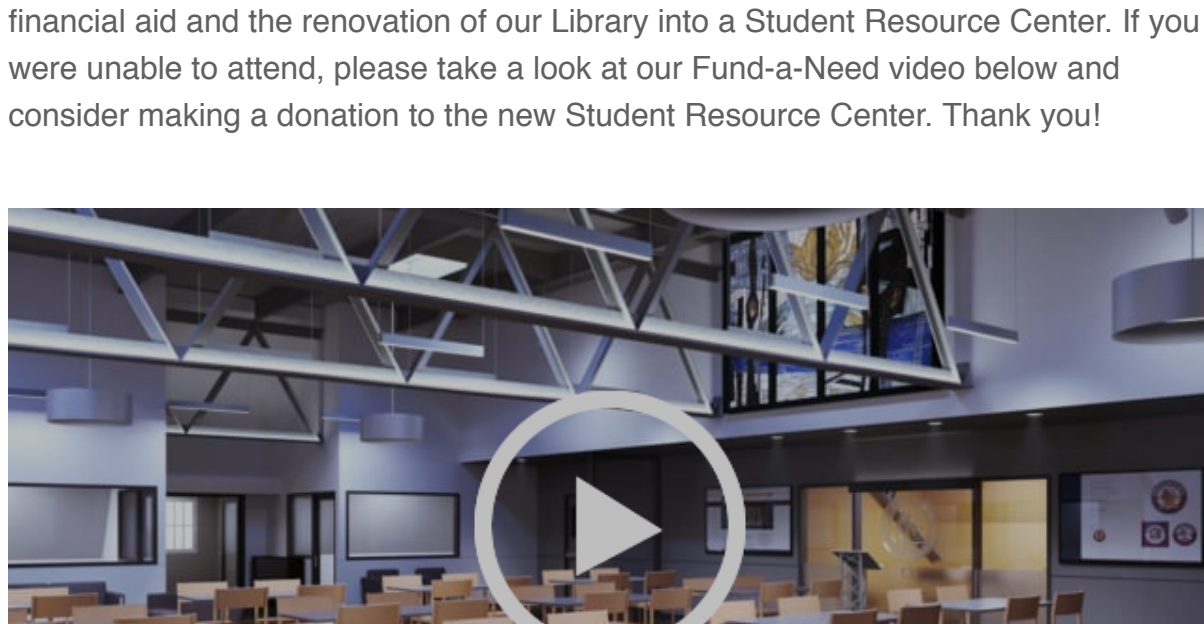
Class of 2019 - Graduation Program
