## GRADING

For the 2020 spring semester, grading scales were modified to include A, B, C or Incomplete options.

During the 2020-2021 school year, we followed our standard grading policy including A, B, C and D grades. Incomplete 1st semester grades were given Credit (CR) with successful completion of 2nd semester course work.

### GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The transcript reflects the student's cumulative grade point average which is determined by all of the courses a student has taken, beginning in the ninth grade. O'Dea does weigh Honors and AP classes. We use a 5.000 grading scale for those courses.

The average 6th semester cumulative GPA for the Class of 2021 is 3.558. The highest cumulative GPA for the class of 2021 is 4.6347 and the lowest is 2.2633.
