Prom Guidelines

TICKET PURCHASE POLICY

- Tickets can be purchased via the form located on the Class of 2022 webpage or in the main office. They are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Guest Forms must be submitted with ticket purchase, they can be found on the O'Dea Class of 2022 website and in the main office.

DANCE GUIDELINES

- All students must arrive to the Bell Harbor Conference Center between 7pm-8pm. Students will not be allowed into the dance until 7pm.
- Students who have not arrived by 8pm will receive a call home by the Dean of Students.
- Students cannot leave the dance until one half-hour before the end of the dance, unless they are escorted out by a parent.
- All students must enter and exit through the Bell Harbor Conference Center main entrance.
- Any student who is suspected of using alcohol or drugs will be sent to the Dean of Students and will be asked to leave.
- All student guests must come prepared to show the dance supervisor proper school photo identification in order to be admitted.
- All student and guests' names on the attendance list must match their school identification.
- We require that all students attending O'Dea dances:
 1. Dance upright
 2. Dance face-to-face
 3. You may not touch anyone without verbally asking permission / gaining consent
 4. Dance in a manner respectful to oneself, one's date, and to others
 5. Dance in small groups that allow space to walk through the dance floor

DRESS GUIDELINES

Dress in formal attire- (boys- tuxedo or suit, dress shirts and pants-with a tie, vest or bowtie; girls-dress or suit)

1. Shirts must be always worn.
2. An O'Dea Administrator will make final determination regarding appropriate dress attire.
3. Dress must be appropriate without any symbols of nudity, illegal substances, or profanity.
4. All clothes must be in good condition without holes or tears.
