## **TICKET PURCHASE POLICY**

- Tickets can be purchased via the form located on the Class of 2022 webpage or in the main office. They are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Guest Forms must be submitted with ticket purchase, they can be found on the O'Dea Class of 2022 website and in the main office.

## **DANCE GUIDELINES**

- All students must arrive to the Bell Harbor Conference Center between 7pm-8pm. Students will not be allowed into the dance until 7pm.
- Students who have not arrived by 8pm will receive a call home by the Dean of Students.
- Students cannot leave the dance until one half-hour before the end of the dance, unless they are escorted out by a parent.
- All students must enter and exit through the Bell Harbor Conference Center main entrance.
- Any student who is suspected of using alcohol or drugs will be sent to the Dean of Students and will be asked to leave.
- All student guests must come prepared to show the dance supervisor proper school photo identification in order to be admitted.
- All student and guests' names on the attendance list must match their school identification.
- We require that all students attending O'Dea dances:
  - 1. Dance upright
  - 2. Dance face-to-face
  - 3. You may not touch anyone without verbally asking permission / gaining consent
  - 4. Dance in a manner respective to oneself, one's date, and to others
  - 5. Dance in small groups that allow space to walk through the dance floor

## **DRESS GUIDELINES**
