COLLEGE REPRESENTATIVE VISITS

- List of colleges can be found on Naviance Student-- Colleges Tab
- The list is also in the Family Bulletin weekly
- Students must sign up for college visits in Naviance, 24 hours before the visit
- Students must have their teacher complete the permission form
- Students are encouraged to attend.
 - The college representative is often the person who reads their application

NAVIANCE

- Naviance is a college search tool
 - Research colleges, look at admissions data, find scholarships, and build college list
 - Ultimately how we send documents
- Link to Naviance Student -- top of the O'Dea website page
- Student user-name -- O'Dea e-mail & O'Dea password
- Colleges MUST be added to the student's college list in Naviance for supporting documents to be sent to a college
- Parents can access their own Naviance account
 - E-mail your student's counselor if you are interested/need access.

COLLEGE LIST

• Student's must fill out an Application Plan

- The "Colleges I'm Applying To" list on Naviance is created by submitting the Application Plan to your counselor
- If a student wants their transcripts or other supporting documents sent to any colleges, they must be added to their Naviance list
- Teacher and Counselor letters won't be started until there is a list of colleges

Seniors: you must bring this completed form when you meet with your college counselor to move/add your schools to your "Colleges I'm Applying To" list on Naviance. No Colleges will be added or letters written without this signed application plan on file. If you have a November 1st deadline, you must meet with your counselor by October 1st. If your first deadline is November 15th, you must meet by October 15th. No letters will be written for EA/ED application deadlines if this plan is not approved by the stated deadlines. A new form is required to add additional schools.

COMMON APPLICATION

- Set up an account on the Common Application website: <u>www.commonapp.org</u>
- FERPA waiver section
 - Privacy Statement: Students must check "I waive my rights to access letters of recommendation" and check "I authorize secondary schools to release requested records".
 - You must waive your rights for us to release transcripts and letters
- Matching Common App with Naviance
 - Once complete CA/FERPA Waiver, students log into Naviance and follow prompts to match their accounts.
- Common Application and Naviance College Lists should <u>match</u>
- If a school is added later, students must let their counselor know so we can send documents

COMMON APP / DIRECT APPS / ETC

- UW: now on the Common App!
 - No more Coalition App- students should not use
- WSU: both on Common App & direct application
- UC Schools: UC Application
- CSU Schools: CSU Apply Application
- Most public institution applications do not require essays or letters of recommendation.
 - Students will still need to list these schools on Naviance so we are able to send O'Dea transcripts as a required part of their applications

SAT/ACT SCORES

- About 75% of colleges have gone Test Optional
 - See full list of Test Optional schools at <u>fairtest.org</u>
- Test-Blind: UW, WSU, U of San Diego, UC-Schools
- Counselors cannot send scores to colleges
- Test scores are not listed on a student's O'Dea transcript





TEACHER & COUNSELOR RECOMMENDATIONS

- Students should have already asked one Junior year for a letter
 - Only highly selective schools require more than one teacher letter
- Students must complete a Teacher Questionnaire in Naviance for the teacher
- Students must complete the College Questionnaire on Naviance before the counselor recommendation can be written
