SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION

EVERY YEAR THAT SUBSTANCE USE IS DELAYED DURING THE PERIOD OF ADOLESCENT BRAIN DEVELOPMENT, THE RISK OF SUBSTANCE ADDICTION AND ABUSE DECREASES.
