Thank You, Coleman Family for over 20 Years of Generosity!

The impact of a Catholic education can inspire others to plan how to help young people receive a faith-based education. In the case of James '32 and Dorothy Coleman, their unwavering support of Catholic education led to the creation of the Coleman Family Foundation, which has ensured that more than 100 young men have received fully funded tuition at O'Dea High School for more than 20 years. Jim and Dorothy passed away before they could see the full impact of their generosity. Still, their four children, who have quietly been overseeing the Foundation since 2002, have had the opportunity to witness the incredible impact their parents' gift has made over the years. As the Foundation winds down its assets, the Coleman family has given us one final gift by allowing us to share their parents' story for the first time.

Jim Coleman was born in Port Angeles in 1915. In his very early years, he attended a one-room school in Lake Quinalt where his mom was the teacher. Once his family moved to Seattle when he was six, he went to school and graduated from St. Joseph School and O'Dea High School. He attended Seattle University, but, due to his father's death, left college early to support his mother. He worked for several years at United Parcel Service (UPS), delivering packages via bicycle throughout downtown Seattle. He enlisted in the Army toward the end of WWII and was deployed to Northern Italy just before Victory in Europe Day.

Upon his return to Seattle, Jim was rehired at UPS, met Dorothy, and in 1946 they married at the St.

James Chapel. Together, they raised a family of four children who all graduated from Catholic high schools. After 42 years, Jim retired from UPS and he and Dorothy spent their time traveling, golfing, and supporting Catholic education, a cause that remained important to them.

In their later years, Jim and Dorothy discussed how they could continue supporting Catholic education after they passed away. After Dorothy's death, to move

forward with their mutual desire, Jim reached out to his former employee and longtime associate, Michael Patterson, for help. Years earlier, as a college student, Michael had worked with Jim at UPS. Now as an attorney and O'Dea alumni father, he worked with Jim to create the mission and

documentation for the Coleman Family Foundation. In 2001, Jim funded the Foundation and in 2002, a donation was made to fully support tuition for the first "Coleman Student" at O'Dea. Jim passed away in early 2002, and while he would never realize the impact of his gift, he was confident his children would continue the mission of the Coleman Family Foundation.

Thus began an incredible relationship of over 21 years between Jim and Dorothy's four children and O'Dea. During that time tuition rose from \$5,000 to \$19,500 and yet, they continued with an unwavering belief in an O'Dea education and the impact their parents' vision was having on our students. With the support of Linda Thornton, O'Dea's former longtime Financial Aid Director, the relationship between O'Dea and the Coleman's children grew. The Colemans have come to O'Dea annually to meet each young man and their families who benefitted from their parents' gift. They have been rewarded by sharing in the students' journeys through their time at O'Dea and observing their growth and development. They watched the students succeed and face challenges, while cheering them on from the sidelines.

The Coleman children recently decided to use all the Foundation's assets, and so began the final few years supporting the last Coleman Students. They feel grateful for the legacy their parents enabled them to be a part of. They continue to pray for

each young man and their families and hope their parents' support is not seen as a handout, but a sign that others care and want the best for them. They hope that if someday the Coleman Students are in a position to support others, they will remember the impact of their parents' generosity and pay it forward.

The Coleman's children feel that the impact their parents' gift had on more than 100 O'Dea students and their families far exceeded Jim and Dorothy's expectations. They also acknowledge that their parents' generosity provided them the opportunity to work closely together for the benefit of others, which has truly been a gift to the entire family. O'Dea has been blessed by Jim, Dorothy, and all the Coleman family. We hope their story will inspire others to plan for the future of Catholic education.

What inspired you to offer internships to O'Dea students? Attending Career Day as a speaker was the event that sparked the inspiration for creating an internship at Profiducia. Dear O’Dea Community,

I am pleased to share with you our Annual Report, which covers financial information for the fiscal year July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023. This is a special report in that it reflects our Centennial year, a remarkable milestone in the

history of O’Dea. It was a privilege and joy to take part in this celebration and share in it with so many of you in our community. Throughout the year we not only celebrated our rich traditions, but laid the groundwork for a bright and promising future.

Thanks to the generosity of our community, O’Dea remains in a sound financial position. As tuition continues to increase, we remain focused on how we can ensure that a Catholic education at O’Dea remains accessible to all. Last year we provided nearly \$2 million in need-based financial aid to 37% of our students. This is a remarkable amount for a school the size of O’Dea, and we are grateful to all of you who helped make it possible.

We also continue to work on improving our campus, which is now expanded to south Seattle with the addition of our new field. Thanks to you we were able to replace 132 windows throughout our historic 1923 building, and we continue to work on developing the field so it can be used on a regular basis by our

students. Our freshman football team practiced on the field in October, so from this point on the Class of 2027 will always be able to say they were the first in O’Dea’s history to use it!

As we reflect on 100 years of educating young men, I want to acknowledge those in the past who had the foresight and desire to support O’Dea’s future. Jim and Dorothy Coleman (story on page 12) knew they wanted to support the future of Catholic education and in doing so, ensured more than 100 young men were able to attend O’Dea for a period of more than 20 years after their passing. Likewise, Helmut and Jutta Wegener, (story on page 11) appreciated their sons’ education at O’Dea so included us in their estate plans years ago. We are now benefitting from the result of that gift. Stories like these are an important reminder to all of us that defining what you want your legacy to be can have a lasting impact on the future of O’Dea.

Thank you for your continued support and unwavering faith in the value and importance of a Catholic education at O’Dea High School. Here’s to the next 100 years!
