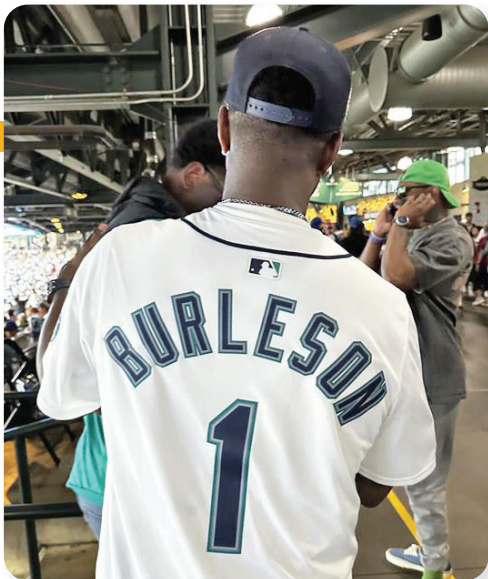

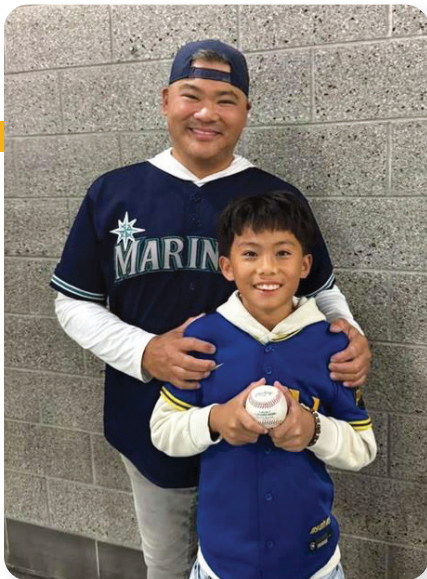
THE FIRST PITCH

And because Nate learned about the importance of giving back while he was a student at O'Dea, he also took the time to pay it forward to three of our current students.



JOURNALISM IN ACTION

Ivan Quispe '26, Torsten Schenck '27, and Gene Woodard III '27, along with their Sports Journalism teacher, Will Chambers, had the opportunity to join Nate at the ballpark. With support from the Mariners, the students practiced their journalism skills by interviewing Nate and taking photos at T-Mobile Park. This experience gave them a unique chance to take their classroom lessons to the real world. Nate spoke with the students about perseverance, gratitude, and faith, values he says were rooted in his O'Dea experience. He also shared that O'Dea is where he learned what it means to lead. His words reflected the strength of the O'Dea brotherhood where mentorship, connection, and opportunity go hand in hand.



THE GAME

That same night, another story captured the spirit of O’Dea’s mission when Marcus Ruelos, son of Galan ’91 and a student at St. Anthony, found himself at the center of a viral moment of kindness. When Mariners catcher Cal Raleigh hit his record-setting 60th home run of the season, the ball ricocheted off Marcus’ mother and into the hands of another fan

nearby. Instead of keeping it, the man turned and handed the ball to Marcus, a gesture that stunned the crowd and quickly made headlines.

Sports memorabilia experts valued the ball at more than \$50,000, but Marcus chose to return it to Cal, saying, “Money doesn’t matter. This is for him. It’s his special moment with his family, just like we had ours.” His father reflected on the moment, sharing, “It was a random act of kindness that made a lifetime memory for our family. Kindness still matters in this world.”

THE WINNINGEST COACH IN WASHINGTON STATE



History was made this fall when Head Football Coach Monte Kohler earned win number 395 and became the all-time leader in Washington State high school football victories. But Coach Kohler's true legacy isn't measured in numbers. It's written in the many lives he has impacted.

After starting his coaching career in Montana with 8-man football, Coach Kohler came to O'Dea in 1985 and built a program defined by heart, discipline, and brotherhood. Over 41 seasons, he won six state championships, never lost more than three games in a season, and guided hundreds of players to college and even some to the pros, many of whom "return to share how Monte's influence guided them well beyond their high school years."

Principal Jim Walker states that "Monte invests in his players and staff as individuals, taking time to know their stories, celebrate their achievements, and support them through challenges." But what truly sets Coach Kohler apart is that his care extends far beyond the field. "Coach just loves everyone," Coach Tim Greenan added. "It doesn't matter who you are or if you even play football. He gives you his respect, his time, and his support. He shows up for other teams, other students, and makes everyone feel seen."

As Hutton Leverett '26 shares, "Coach Kohler is always making us better, not just as football players, but as young men. He mentors us, guides us on the right path, and sacrifices so much of his time for the team. We all love Coach Kohler and are incredibly grateful for everything he does."

CROSS COUNTRY

At forty students strong, this year's cross-country program was a vibrant and welcoming team of student-athletes. Working with Head Coach, Jackson Derby, faculty member, and Assistant Coach David Bazzi '96, the runners showed up each day ready to work hard and support one another.

The team participated in many meets, including one weekend in Spokane where they competed in a race and also visited Gonzaga University to learn about college life and the opportunities available to student-athletes. This experience deepened their connection to each other and inspired them to think about their futures. Congratulations to the whole team for a great season and to Maddox Fox '26 and Heath Atrosh '27 for earning their way to the state championship meet in Pasco!

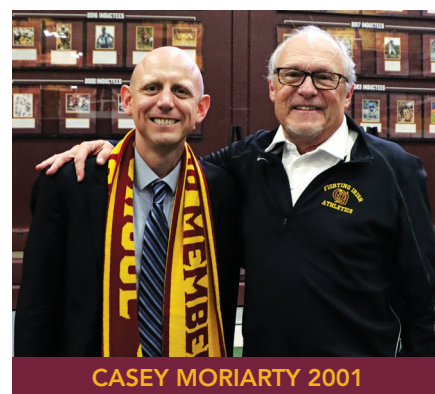
TIM GREENAN 1980

Tim has been part of O'Dea football for more than 30 years, including as coach of the offensive line and linebackers during O'Dea's "Scoreless in Seattle" State Championship season. He has played a key role in five State Championship teams.



PAT LAVIN 1999

Pat earned many athletic honors at O'Dea, while also serving as student body president and being named valedictorian. At Harvard University, he earned three varsity letters and was named Verizon Academic All-Ivy League. Today, he supports youth programs to positively impact student-athletes' character and accountability.



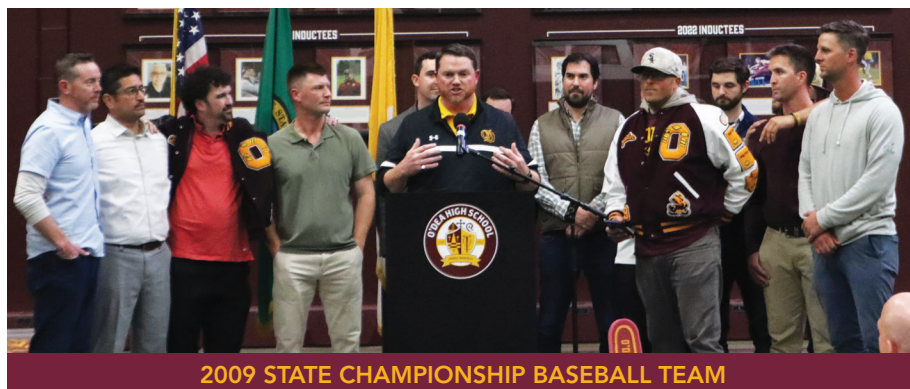
CASEY MORIARTY 2001

A decorated runner at O'Dea, Casey was also a standout athlete at Yale University. Later, while attending law school at Seattle University, he won the GNAC Cross Country Championship, and earned All-American honors with a 15th-place finish at the 2005 NCAA Division II Championship.

A standout three-sport athlete at O'Dea, Johri excelled in football, basketball, and track. His senior year he earned multiple state awards and received a #66 national ESPN ranking. Johri earned a full-ride scholarship to the University of Washington.

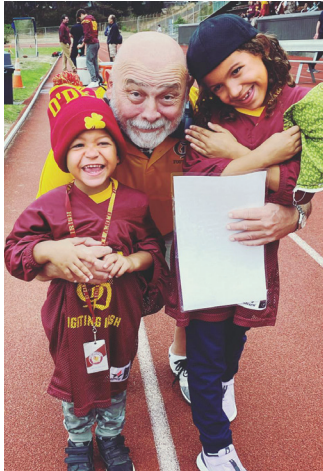

After 34 years of dedicated service as a counselor, teacher and coach, Mike Crotty is retiring from his full-time role at O'Dea.

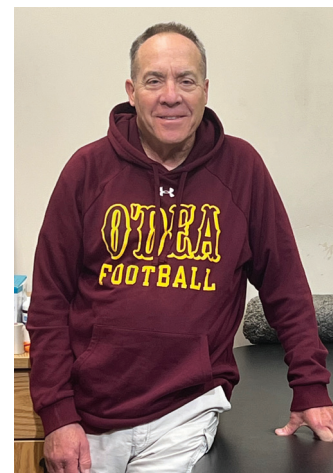

As I reflect on the past year, I am grateful for your generosity, trust, and faith that continues to sustain O'Dea High School. Your commitment ensures that our mission to form young men of character, faith, and service remains strong today and for generations to come.

Thanks to your support through the capital campaign, we made significant and lasting investments in our campus. We completed essential improvements to safeguard our buildings and ensure their longevity. We also preserved and celebrated O'Dea's rich history and Catholic identity by repairing our stained-glass window and lighting historic architectural elements of our 1923 building. Looking ahead, we are thrilled to open Kohler Field in the coming year, which will expand our campus to the south Seattle area. This transformational addition will support our athletic program and provide all students space to gather and grow.

The campaign also supported the endowment fund, held at the O'Dea High School Foundation, a source of financial stability and accessibility. Assets in this fund, which are restricted for need-based financial aid, now total nearly \$19 million, a remarkable increase of

\$7 million, or nearly 60%, over the past four years. This growth, driven by both contributions and favorable market performance, enhances our ability to fund tuition assistance in perpetuity, ensuring an O'Dea education remains within reach for all qualified young men.

In addition, we continue to look to the future through a thoughtful review of our organizational structure, guided by our current strategic plan. The landscape of Catholic education is evolving, and it is our responsibility to adapt while remaining true to our mission and O'Dea experience that defines our community. We look forward to sharing the results of this important work in the future.

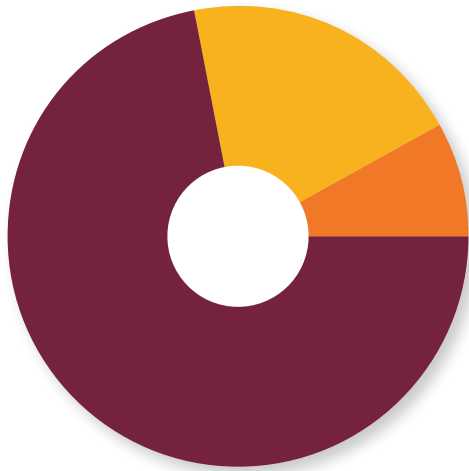
O'Dea is a Catholic high school whose mission is to educate young men and prepare them to be men of character, faith and service.

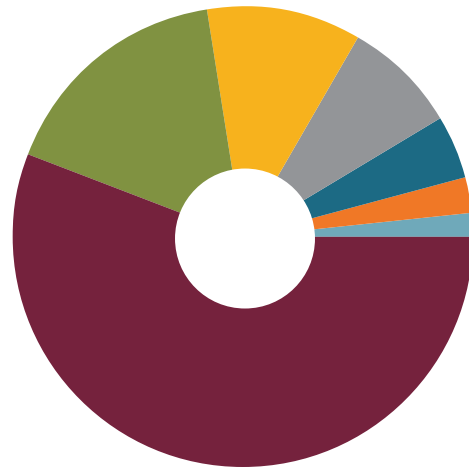

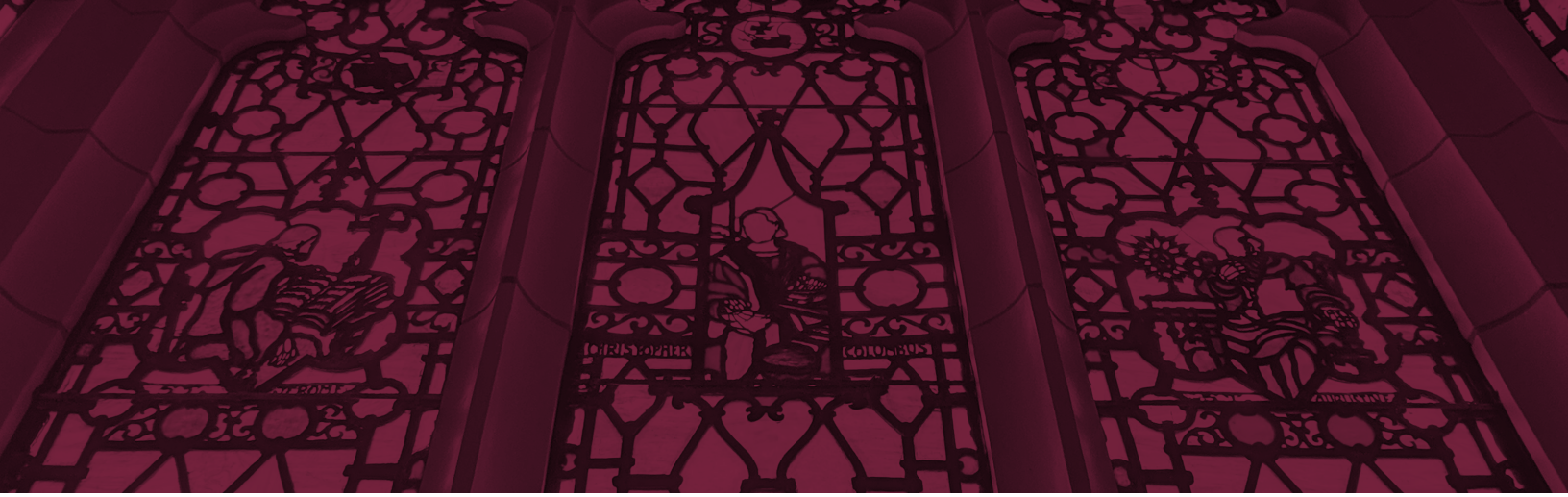
